Thank you for your interest in becoming a Pathways' Volunteer Provider. Our Provider Volunteers are an essential part of Pathways' mission. **Who We Are:** Pathways is a non-profit, volunteer-sustained organization that provides programs and an environment designed to support a *creative healing response to illness*. This *creative healing response* speaks to three elements; the mysterious nature of healing, the infinite possibilities for healing and the fact that healing is always available even when a cure is not. At Pathways, we understand that holistic health care vitalizes this *creative healing response* and should be accessible to everyone regardless of their ability to pay for it.

**Who We Serve:** We serve people experiencing life-threatening illness, chronic illness, challenging life transitions (such as divorce, retirement & grief) as well as those who identify as caregivers. We welcome ALL people and are working to deepen our skills as an organization (staff, board and providers) in order to comprehensively serve individuals with marginalized identities such as BIPOC and LGBTQIA+ identities.

What We Do: Pathways offers a safe place to explore whole-person healing through group classes and one-on-one individualized sessions in diverse areas of holistic health. Our service categories include <u>Bodywork;</u>

<u>Energy Healing; Meditation, Imagery & Inner Practice; Mind-Body-Spirit Healing; Movement & Guided</u>

<u>Practice; Art, Music & Creativity; Health, Wellness & Nutrition and Transformation through Change, Grief</u>

<u>& Loss.</u> Pathways' services are available at no cost thanks to the generosity of our volunteer providers. We also offer many special programs throughout the year that are open to the wider community. On rare occasions, these special programs are fundraisers for Pathways and a registration fee applies. We currently serve the community in both in-person and virtual capacities.

**Becoming a Provider:** Our Volunteer Providers are highly skilled healers, practitioners and/or facilitators with a passion for the work they do and the people they serve. ### **Required Qualifications**

- At least 100 hours working (in a paid or volunteer capacity) in the specific modality offered at Pathways
- Actively practice the modality offered at Pathways
- Ability to provide a safe, non-judgmental space for participants to experience healing
- Commitment to not imposing personal (spiritual, religious or other) beliefs on others
- Willingness to participate in required Diversity, Equity and Inclusion trainings

### **Preferred Qualifications**

- Experience working with people facing life-threatening or chronic illness
- Experience working with people of diverse backgrounds and identities (BIPOC, LGBTQIA+, disabled)
- Ability to articulate a personal healing philosophy
